Hybrid Learning at Civano (K-8)

Monday - Thursday

- 8:30am - 2:00pm in classrooms
- 2:00pm-3:00pm - AT HOME; expectation to work remotely on assigned work, reading, projects, and homework
- Art, Music, PE during school day
- Kinder: leave at 11:30 OR choose all day K (discounted - \$150 per month for all day)

Friday

- All students will work remotely from Schoology or other assigned lessons and activities

Brick to Click Learning at Civano K-5

Monday - Thursday

- AM - students will work remotely from Schoology on their timeline
- PM - Teachers will establish days and times to offer remote support.
- Example: Monday, ELA 2:15 - 2:45; Tuesday, Math 2:15 - 2:45

Friday

- Video conference support from teachers at scheduled times.
- Example: 9:00-9:30 Math /10:00-10:30 Reading/ELA / 11:00-11:30 SS/SCI

Brick to Click Learning at Civano 6-8

Monday - Thursday

- AM - students will work remotely from Schoology on their timeline OR join their classes remotely as scheduled
- PM - Teachers will establish days and times to offer remote support.
- Example: Monday, 2:15 - 2:45, ELA/Humanities; Tuesday, 2:15 - 2:45 Math; Thursday, 2:15-2:45 Science

Friday

- Video conference support from teachers at scheduled times.
- Example: 9:00-9:30 Math /10:00-10:30 Humanities / 11:00-11:30 SCI

Hybrid Learning

Smaller Groups -- your cohort, your pod, your **bubble**, your squad, or your “quaranteam” -- intended to minimize the number of students in a classroom together. Student groups will be limited to classmates -- Students will be in the same classroom, take breaks together, eat together, etc.

As the need arises, students may have to use **Brick to Click** for short periods of time.

Personal Responsibility -- Our small community school needs everyone’s cooperation in order for our school to be able to return to Hybrid Instruction. We ask that all families practice daily health checks and stay home if they have any illness. Questions about symptoms and how long a student should stay home can be answered by the school office.

Acknowledgement of COVID-19 Liability Insurance -- This will be emailed to parents via eSignGenie and is required to be signed and returned prior to students starting hybrid learning.

Masks -- Students must wear masks properly at school when they are unable to physically distance outside, and always inside. We HIGHLY encourage families practice this before school resumes.

Arriving at School

School starts at 8:30am on both campuses; students can arrive to campus no sooner than 8:15

- Youngers - front gate
- Middlers & Olders - gate near kitchen
- Upper School -- gates at Upper School

Daily Temperature & Wellness Check AT SCHOOL GATES

Students & Staff **only** inside school gates and school office (office will be closed until school begins at 8:30am; please make appointment if you need to speak w/Lydia or Nicole)

Students will report to classroom until school begins.

Recess & Lunch

- Students will have two physical activity breaks a day for 15 minutes each.
- Students will only have break with their class.
- If students are able to maintain physical distance outside, they can take a mask break; otherwise, they are expected to wear a mask.
- Students must bring lunch from home. Microwaves and refrigerators will not be available. Lunch should not need to be heated or prepared by an adult.
- Depending upon the numbers of students enrolled in Hybrid Learning, we may be able to eat outside in the MPR.

Dismissal

Dismissal Begins at 2:00pm



Students will be dismissed every 5 minutes by last name in order to prevent congestion in all areas -- 2pm A-E; 2:05 F-M; 2:10 N-R; 2:15 S-Z
